## Panel Proposal Submission Requirements

Proposals should include the following:

- Title of the Panel.
- Technical Description (Up to 350 words).
- Moderator and Panelists' Information: Name, affiliations, contact information and short biography (150 words max. per person).
- Written panel logistics, speaker order, and discussion flow in your submission.
- Promotional or commercial discussions are not allowed.
- Panel duration will be 60-minutes.

Panel Proposal Evaluation Criteria:

- Creativity, clarity and quality.
- Significant industry involvement.
- Collaborative cross-disciplinary topics or teams.
- Follow the conference technical scopes.

Panel proposals are due on **15 March 2024**. Please [submit all related materials via this link](#). Selected panels will be notified by 18 April 2024 with potential revisions requested before the conference.

## Conference Paper Submission Requirements

Papers (maximum length five (5) pages) must be prepared in accordance with the [PES Authors Kit](#). Full papers must be submitted to the on-line submission and review site. A link to the submission site will be available from the [PES website on 10 March 2024](#). All papers must be submitted by **20 April 2024**. Authors will be advised via email of acceptance or rejection of the paper by 5 July 2024. If revisions are required, authors will be notified prior to that date.

## Paper Selection

Submission of a paper does not guarantee acceptance. Quality and relevancy of the submitted paper is the highest priority for acceptance. Papers will undergo a rigorous review process via the IEEE PES Technical Committees.

## Presentation of Conference Papers

All accepted conference papers will be scheduled for presentation at the poster sessions. Presentation of an accepted paper at the conference is a requirement of publication. Any paper that is not presented at the conference will not be included in IEEE Xplore.

## Conference Registration

All panelists and moderators must attend the conference in-person and must register for the meeting and pay the appropriate fee. At least one author of each accepted conference paper must register for the meeting and pay the appropriate fee. Conference papers will not be released for publication in the 2025 PES Grid Edge Technologies Conference & Expo Proceedings unless the fee is paid.

As we did in 2023, it is expected that the Grid Edge program will also include over 130 exhibitors, exhibit floor stage presentations and a PhD dissertation competition. Additional information about the event will be posted as it is available.
